 - "K.(1) In addition to any authority provided to the district in this Section, the district may levy and collect a hotel occupancy tax within the district on developments constructed on and after August 1, 2023, which shall be in lieu of other such taxes levied by other taxing authorities within the district. The funds shall be pledged to and used to pay revenue bonds issued by the district or for any other financing of the property of a project, including, but not limited to, loans, mortgages, bonds, or certificates of indebtedness.
 - (2)(a) The term "hotel" means any establishment engaged in the business of furnishing or providing rooms intended or designed for dwelling, lodging, or sleeping purposes to transient guests where such establishment consists of ten or more guest rooms but does not include overnight camping facilities, bed and breakfasts, or short-term rentals. In addition, the term "hotel" does not include any hospital, convalescent or nursing home or sanitarium, or any hotel-like facility operated by or in connection with a hospital or medical clinic providing rooms exclusively for patients and their families.
 - (b) The term "short-term rentals" as used in this Subsection shall mean and include the rental of all or any portion of a residential dwelling unit for dwelling, lodging, or sleeping purposes to one party with a duration of occupancy of less than thirty consecutive days.
 - (2) The tax shall be imposed by resolution of the board and shall be adopted only after the question of the imposition of the hotel occupancy tax has been approved by the Lake Charles City Council and by a majority of the qualified electors voting on the proposition at an election held for that purpose and conducted in accordance with the Louisiana Election Code. The purpose and rate of the tax shall be provided in the resolution."
