**1** AMENDMENT NO. 1**2** On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning of line  
**3** 3, delete "R.S. 14:87.1(b)(iv)" and insert the following:**4** "R.S. 14:87.1(1)(b)(ii), (iii), and (v), (6), and (19)(a)"**5** AMENDMENT NO. 2**6** On page 1, line 6, after "Section 1." and before "are" change "R.S. 14:87.1(1)(b)(iii) and (v),  
**7** (4)(c), (6) and (19)(a)" to "R.S. 14:87.1(1)(b)(ii), (iii), and (v), (6), and (19)(a)"**8** AMENDMENT NO. 3**9** On page 1, between lines 16, and 17, insert the following:**10** "(ii) The removal of a dead unborn child or the inducement or delivery of the  
**11** uterine contents in case of a positive diagnosis, certified in writing in the woman's  
**12** medical record along with the results of an obstetric ultrasound test, that the  
**13** pregnancy has ended or is in the unavoidable and untreatable process of ending due  
**14** to spontaneous miscarriage, also known in medical terminology as spontaneous  
**15** abortion, missed abortion, inevitable abortion, incomplete abortion, or septic  
**16** abortion, including a spontaneous, profound, and irremediable complication of the  
**17** pregnancy that makes the carriage to term of the unborn child unlikely due to the  
**18** profound and irremediable spontaneous complication."**19** AMENDMENT NO. 4**20** On page 1, line 17, after "pregnancy" and before the comma "," insert "or any variant of a  
**21** molar pregnancy"**22** AMENDMENT NO. 5**23** On page 1, delete line 19 in its entirety and insert "\* \* \*"**24** AMENDMENT NO. 6**25** On page 2, delete lines 10 through 16 in their entirety**26** AMENDMENT NO. 7**27** On page 3, line 1, after "child" and before "due" change "likely" to "unlikely"
