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COURTS/COURT REPORTERS Provides relative to transcription fees charged by court reporters in the Thirty-Sixth Judicial District

Purpose of Bill: This bill removes the minimum and maximum fee cap restrictions for court reporter transcript fees that are set by the judges of the 36th Judicial District. The provisions of this bill will become effective if and when the Judicial Council provides a recommendation in its report to the Louisiana Legislature as required by R.S. 13:62.

Note: The provisions of this bill were not included in the Report of the Judicial Council to the Louisiana State Legislature Regarding Requests for Costs and Fees dated February 28, 2023.
