<u>Proposed law</u> provides for any person 18 to 40 to give written consent and indicate their intention to donate bone marrow on their driver's license application. <u>Proposed law</u> further indicates applicants that give consent will allow their genetic information to be obtained and stored in a national database and accessible by cancer doctors.

Effective July 1, 2024.
