Abstract: Provides Medicaid coverage for mental health and substance abuse services via the Psychiatric Collaborative Care Model.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires Medicaid to provide coverage for mental health and substance abuse services delivered through evidence-based, integrated behavioral healthcare models, such as the Psychiatric Collaborative Care Model.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires any medical necessity determinations made for a recipient of Medicaid services to comply with the provisions set forth in <u>present law</u> and the rules promulgated by the La. Dept. of Health.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "Medicaid", "mental health or substance abuse services", and "Psychiatric Collaborative Care Model".

Effective when an Act of the Louisiana Legislature containing a specific appropriation of monies for the implementation of the provisions of the <u>proposed law</u> becomes effective.
