

1 WHEREAS, this information on security threats, criminal activity, drug use and
2 overdose rates, including fentanyl deaths, illegal immigration statistics, including releases
3 by the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, and other specific threats that
4 endanger the health and safety of citizens of Louisiana are critical to providing the
5 Legislature of Louisiana with accurate information to craft policy that protects the citizens
6 of Louisiana.

7 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
8 urge and request the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness
9 and the Louisiana State Police to provide a monthly joint report by electronic mail to the
10 Legislature of Louisiana on security threats, criminal activity, drug use and overdose rates,
11 including fentanyl deaths, illegal immigration statistics, including releases by the United
12 States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, and other specific threats that endanger the
13 health and safety of citizens of Louisiana.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
15 director of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness and
16 the superintendent of the Louisiana State Police.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the director of the Governor's Office of
18 Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness and the superintendent of the Louisiana
19 State Police shall submit each report in the form of an email to the David R. Poynter
20 Legislative Research Library each month the report is due and shall include the name of the
21 submitting agency. The email shall clearly indicate the applicable reporting period and list
22 the name and contact information of the person submitting the email.
