Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana. PUBLIC PROPERTY: Authorizes the exchange of certain state property in Orleans Parish

1	AN ACT	
2	To authorize and provide for the transfer of certain state property; to authorize the exchange	
3	of certain state property in Orleans Parish; to provide for property descriptions; to	
4	provide for the reservation of mineral rights; to provide terms and conditions; to	
5	provide an effective date; and to provide for related matters.	
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:	
7	Section 1. The commissioner of administration and the Louisiana Stadium and	
8	Exposition District, or either of them, notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,	
9	are hereby authorized and empowered to convey, transfer, assign, lease, or deliver any	
10	interest, excluding mineral rights, the state may have in and to all or any portion of the	
11	following described property to the city of New Orleans for the property described in Section	
12	2 of this Act:	
13	DUNCAN PLAZA AND HEAL GARAGE PARCELS	
14 15 16	Three certain parcels or portions of ground, together with all buildings and improvements thereupon, situated in the First Municipal District of the City of New Orleans which are more fully described as follows:	
17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26	Parcel "A" A certain portion of ground designated as A in Square 340 bounded by LaSalle, Gravier, S. Liberty, and Perdido Streets, commencing at the intersection of S. Liberty and Gravier Streets and thence measuring 436.10' along S. Liberty Street, thence at an interior angle of 81°08'40" a distance and front of 199.89' along the new property line of Perdido Street, thence at an interior angle of 98°50'40" a distance and front of 436.26' along the new property line of LaSalle Street, thence at an interior angle of 81°03'55" a distance and front of 199.85' along Gravier Street, to the point of beginning.

## 2 A certain portion of street area in S. Liberty Street designated as B bounded by 3 Square 340, Gravier Street, Square 333, and Perdido Street, commencing at the 4 intersection of Gravier and S. Liberty Streets and measuring along the front of 5 Square 340 a distance of 436.10', thence at an interior angle of 98°51'15" a distance 6 of 38.82' along the new property line of Perdido Street projected, thence at an interior angle of 81°08'45" a distance of 436.03' along the front of Square 333, 7 8 thence at an interior angle of 98°56'40" a distance of 38.83' along the property line 9 of Gravier Street, projected to the point of beginning.

10 11 Parcel "C"

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- A certain portion of ground designated as C in Square 333 bounded by S. Liberty, Gravier, Loyola, and Perdido Streets, commencing at the intersection of S. Liberty and Gravier Streets, and measuring a distance of 436.03' along the front of Square 333, thence at an interior angle of 32°26'46" a distance of 469.54', thence at an interior angle of 66°29'42" a distance of 255.03' along the property line of Gravier Street to the point of beginning.
- All in accordance with survey by C.A. Wethern, Jr., Asst. Survey and Research
  Engineer, and approved by L.M. Buja, Chief Engineer, Engineering Division,
  September 10, 1954, bearing Drawing #1/1-E-la-7872.
- 22 Section 2. In exchange for the above described property in Section 1, the
- 23 commissioner of administration and the Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District, or either
- 24 of them, notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, are hereby authorized and
- 25 empowered to accept, in addition to any other consideration, delivery of title to all or any
- 26 portion of the following described property from the city of New Orleans:
- 27 ORLEANS CIVIL DISTRICT COURT PARCEL
- A certain tract or parcel of land, together with the improvements thereon, being situated in the city of New Orleans at the northwest corner of the intersection of Poydras Street and Loyola Avenue and currently occupied by the Orleans Civil Courts building, containing approximately 36,100 square feet, but excluding the land and improvements occupied by the New Orleans City Hall and related facilities, being a portion of the property more fully described as:
- A portion of ground, together with all buildings and improvements thereupon,
  situated in the First Municipal District of the City of New Orleans, Parish of Orleans,
  State of Louisiana, bounded by Loyola Avenue, Poydras, LaSalle and Perdido Streets
  and more fully described as follows:
- 38 Commencing at the northeast intersection of Poydras Street and Lovola Avenue 39 being the point of beginning, thence proceed along the R/W line of Poydras Street 40 running in the direction of and to LaSalle Street a distance of 763.27' to a point and 41 corner; thence proceed along the R/W line of LaSalle Street in the direction of 42 Perdido Street a distance of 401.14' to a point and corner; thence proceed along the 43 R/W line of Perdido Street and in the direction of Loyola Avenue a distance of 44 666.45' to a point; thence proceed along the R/W line of Loyola Avenue running in 45 the direction of and to Poydras Street a distance of 398.09' to a point, being the point 46 of beginning.
- 47 All measurements are more or less, being composed of portions of Squares 305, 332,
  48 and 341 and portions of former S. Liberty Street, and former Loyola Avenue.

- 3 <u>LA SALLE STREET PARCEL</u>

A 60,267.04 square foot parcel of land located in the First Municipal District, City of New Orleans, Orleans Parish, State of Louisiana; beginning at a point at the intersection of the southern right of way of Poydras Street and the western right of way of LaSalle Street. From the point of beginning, thence S77°20'03"E along the southern right of way line of Poydras Street for a distance of 69.21 feet to a point at the intersection of the Eastern right of way line of LaSalle Street, thence S23°21'35"W along the eastern right of way line of LaSalle Street for a distance of 892.69 feet to a point at the intersection of the northern right of way line of Girod Street, thence N66°38'25"W along the northern right of way line of Girod Street for a distance of 68.00 feet to a point at the intersection of the western right of way line of LaSalle Street, thence N23°21'34"E along the western right of way of LaSalle Street for a distance of 879.85 feet to the point of beginning.

22 Commencing at the intersection of the eastern right of way line of Magnolia Street 23 and the northern right of way line of Julia Street proceed in an easterly direction 24 along the northern right of way line of Julia Street a distance of 69.28' to a point. 25 Thence in a northerly direction at an angle of 74°07'12" with the last previously 26 described line a distance of 46.81' to a point. Thence in a westerly direction at an 27 angle of 90°00'00" with the last previously described line a distance of 630.62' to a 28 point. Thence in a northerly direction at an angle of 74°04'12" with the last 29 previously described line a distance of 77.53' to the point of beginning. Thence 30 continue in a northerly direction on a projection of the last previously described line 31 a distance of 5.67' to a point. Thence in an easterly direction at an interior angle of 32 105°55'48" with the last previously described line a distance of 1335.78' to a point. 33 Thence in a northerly direction at an interior angle of 270°00'00" with the last 34 previously described line a distance of 67.05' to a point. Thence in an easterly 35 direction at an interior angle of 79°19'52" with the last previously described line a 36 distance of 69.20' to a point. Thence in a southerly direction at an interior angle of 37 100°40'06" with the last previously described line a distance of 35.56' to a point. 38 Thence in an easterly direction along the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 39 264.87' a distance of 242.99' to a point of reverse curvature. Thence along the arc of 40 a curve to the right having a radius of 354.27' a distance of 71.09' to a point on the 41 northern right of way line of Cypress Street. Thence in an easterly direction along 42 the northern right of way line of Cypress Street a distance of 12.79' to a point. 43 Thence in a northerly direction at an interior angle of 240°20'01" with the last previously described line a distance of 8.11' to a point. Thence in an easterly 44 45 direction at an interior angle of 109°26'56" with the last previously described line a 46 distance of 6.66' to a point. Thence in a southerly direction at an interior angle of 47 89°34'30" with the last previously described line a distance of 104.87' to a point. 48 Thence in a southwesterly direction along the arc of a curve to the left having a 49 radius of 259.27' a distance of 35.31' to a point of reverse curvature. Thence along 50 the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 359.87' a distance of 270.08' to a 51 point of tangency. Thence in a westerly direction a distance of 1143.28' to a point. 52 Thence in a northwesterly direction at an interior angle of 164°07'12" with the last 53 previously described line a distance of 272.46' to the point of beginning.

- 1 Said parcel contains 139,512 square feet.
- 2 AND

3 Commencing at the intersection of the eastern right of way line of Magnolia Street 4 and the northern right of way line of Julia Street proceed in an easterly direction 5 along the northern right of way line of Julia Street a distance of 69.28' to a point. 6 Thence in a northerly direction at an angle of 74°07'12" with the last previously 7 described line a distance of 46.81' to a point. Thence in a westerly direction at an 8 angle of 90°00'00" with the last previously described line a distance of 347.28' to the 9 point of beginning. Thence continue in a westerly direction on a projection of the 10 last previously described line a distance of 283.34' to a point. Thence in a northerly direction at an angle of 74°04'12" with the last previously described line a distance 11 12 of 77.53' to a point. Thence in an easterly direction at an interior angle of 90°03'00" 13 with the last previously described line a distance of 272.46' to the point of beginning.

- 14 Said parcel contains 10,562 square feet.
- 15 WEST STADIUM DRIVE PARCEL

A certain parcel or portion of ground, together with all buildings and improvements
thereupon, designated as Parcel 20 AL and situated in the First Municipal District of
the City of New Orleans, which according to a plan by Adloe Orr, Jr. & Associates,
Consulting Engineers and Land Planners, dated March 10, 1971, is more fully
described as follows:

21 Commencing at the intersection of the southern right of way line of Poydras Street 22 and the eastern right of way line of South Claiborne Avenue proceed in a southerly 23 direction along the eastern right of way line of South Claiborne Avenue a distance 24 of 99.42' to the point of beginning. Thence continue in a southerly direction along 25 the eastern right of way line of South Claiborne Avenue a distance of 476.62' to a 26 point. Thence in a southerly direction at an interior angle of 151°15'180" with the last previously described line a distance of 52.00' to a point. Thence in a southerly 27 28 direction at an interior angle of 180°38'07" with the last previously described line a 29 distance of 324.25' to a point. Thence in an easterly direction at an interior angle of 30 119°32'51" with the last previously described line a distance of 95.18' to a point. 31 Thence in a northerly direction at an interior angle of 74°07'12" with the last 32 previously described line a distance of 851.46' to a point. Thence in a northeasterly 33 direction along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 119.42' a distance 34 of 3.59' to a point. Thence in a westerly direction a distance of 65.32' to the point of 35 beginning.

36 Said parcel contains 107,022 square feet.

37 Section 3. The commissioner of administration and the Louisiana Stadium and

- 38 Exposition District, or either of them, are hereby authorized to enter into such agreements,
- 39 covenants, conditions, and stipulations and to execute such documents as may be necessary
- 40 to properly effectuate any conveyance, transfer, assignment, lease, or delivery of title,
- 41 excluding mineral rights, to the property described in Section 1 of this Act, and as more
- 42 specifically described in any such agreements entered into and documents executed by and
- 43 between the parties in exchange for consideration, including the property described in

- 1 Section 2 of this Act, proportionate to the appraised value of the property in Section 1 of this
- 2 Act.
- 3 Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
- 4 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
- 5 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
- 6 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 7 effective on the day following such approval.

Authorizes the commissioner of administration and the La. Stadium and Exposition District to exchange certain state property in Orleans Parish for certain property owned by the city of New Orleans. Provides for the reservation of mineral rights to the state.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Natural Resources and</u> <u>Environment</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

- 1. Add authority for the La. Stadium and Exposition District to transfer state property in exchange for city property.
- 2. Add property descriptions for the state properties the commissioner and La. Stadium and Exposition District are authorized to transfer and the city properties they are authorized to receive in exchange.
