To commend Breka Peoples for her community service.

WHEREAS, Mrs. Peoples has received numerous awards and honors for her activism, including the Louisiana Lefty Organizing Award and the Ralph Waldo Emerson Award; she is most deserving of the highest recognition for her commitment to community service.
