Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to Original Senate Resolution No. 96 by Senator Mizell

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- On page 1, line 3, after "marijuana" insert a comma and "hemp containing THC, and
 kratom"
- 4 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 5 On page 3, at the end of line 5, delete the period and insert "; and"
- 6 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 7 On page 3, between lines 5 and 6, insert the following:

8 9 10	"WHEREAS, Act No. 164 of the 2019 Regular Session provided for the regulation of industrial hemp and industrial hemp-derived CBD products; and
11 12 13 14	WHEREAS, Louisiana law regulating industrial hemp was amended in the following years by Act No. 344 of the 2020 Regular Session, Act No. 336 of the 2021 Regular Session, which provided for consumable hemp products, and Act No. 458 of the 2022 Regular Session; and
15 16 17 18 19	WHEREAS, R.S. 3:1481 defines hemp as the plant Cannabis sativa L. and any part of that plant, including the seeds thereof and all derivatives, extracts, cannabinoids, isomers, acids, salts, and salts of isomers, whether growing or not, with a total delta-9 THC concentration of not more than 0.3 percent on a dry weight basis; and
20 21	WHEREAS, R.S. 3:1481 also defines THC as a combination of tetrahydrocannabinol and tetrahydrocannabinolic acid; and
22 23	WHEREAS, both hemp and marijuana plants are the same species, with the main difference being how much of THC each contains; and
24 25 26 27	WHEREAS, kratom is a preparation made from the leaves of Mitragyna speciosa, an evergreen tree that grows naturally in Southeast Asia, which can be used as either a sedative or a stimulant depending upon the amount consumed; and
28 29	WHEREAS, the United States Food and Drug Administration warns consumers not to use kratom; and
30 31	WHEREAS, there are no approved Food and Drug Administration (FDA) uses for kratom; and
32 33	WHEREAS, R.S. 40:989.3 prohibits the distribution of any product containing kratom to a minor; and
34 35	WHEREAS, the FDA has raised concerns about the toxicity and possible death with the use of kratom; and
36 37	WHEREAS, Act No. 231 of the 2019 Regular Session provides for Mitragynine to be added to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances

- Law if and when the Drug Enforcement Administration of the United States
 classifies Mitragyna as a controlled dangerous substance; and
- WHEREAS, the legislature needs reliable data regarding actual adverse effects in order to safeguard the health and well-being of Louisiana residents and properly regulate medical marijuana, hemp containing THC, and kratom."
