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SB 74 Reengrossed2023 Regular SessionConnick

Proposed law creates the Southeast Louisiana Port Authority Advisory Commission.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the purpose of the commission and identifies the ports the commission represents which are located along and near the lower Mississippi River.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for duties and responsibilities of the commission including preparing a maritime port mission plan, developing a one-, five-, and ten-year plan, reviewing each project eligible to be funded under the port construction and development priority program and making recommendations to the legislature.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the composition of board of commissioners, compensation of the commission, meetings, and quorum requirements.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals the La. International Deep Water Gulf Transfer Terminal Authority. Makes this provision effective Dec. 31, 2023.

- 2. Change the composition of the commissioners on the board by replacing the president of the board of commissioners for the Port of Greater Baton Rouge or his designee with the executive director of the Port of Greater Baton Rouge or his designee.
