ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: Provides relative to alcoholic beverages

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> provides restrictions of container sizes for distilled spirits sold in or shipped into the state of La.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and authorizes the sale or shipment of distilled spirits in 700 ml containers. Provides further that a case of 700 ml containers shall consist of 12 containers.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if any supplier ships a particular product of a distilled spirit into this state in a 750 ml container, then he is prohibited from shipping that product of beverage into the state in a 700 ml container.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

(Amends R.S. 26:351(1)(a) and (3)(a); adds R.S.26:351(1)(c))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

- 1. Authorize the sale or shipment of distilled spirits in 1.80 L containers and provide that 1.80 L containers shall be packed with 6 containers per case.
- 2. Provide an effective date.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary B to the reengrossed bill

- 1. Makes technical changes.
- 2. Removes provision that authorized the sale or shipment of distilled spirits in 1.80 L containers and removed provision that 1.80 L containers be packed with 6 containers per case.
- 3. Adds provision that if any supplier ships a particular product of a distilled spirit into this state in a 750ml container, then he is prohibited from shipping that product of beverage into the state in a 700 ml container.
