It is unlawful for any person who has been convicted of, or has been 10 found not guilty by reason of insanity for, a crime of violence as defined in R.S. 11 14:2(B) which is a felony or simple burglary, burglary of a pharmacy, burglary of an 12 inhabited dwelling, unauthorized entry of an inhabited dwelling, felony illegal use of weapons or dangerous instrumentalities, manufacture or possession of a delayed 13 14 action incendiary device, manufacture or possession of a bomb, or possession of a 15 firearm while in the possession of or during the sale or distribution of a controlled dangerous substance, or any violation of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous 16 17 Substances Law which is a felony, or any crime which is defined as a sex offense in R.S. 15:541, or any crime defined as an attempt to commit one of the above-18 19 enumerated offenses under the laws of this state, or who has been convicted under 20 the laws of any other state or of the United States or of any foreign government or 21 country of a crime which, if committed in this state, would be one of the above-22 enumerated crimes, any of the following offenses or attempts to commit any of them to possess a firearm or carry a concealed weapon -: 23 (1) Any felony crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2(B). 24 25 (2) Any sex offense as defined in R.S. 15:541. (3) Simple burglary, simple burglary of a pharmacy, simple burglary of an 26 inhabited dwelling, or unauthorized entry of an inhabited dwelling. 27 28 (4) Felony illegal use of weapons or dangerous instrumentalities. 29 (5) Manufacture or possession of a delayed action incendiary device. 30 (6) Manufacture or possession of a bomb. (7) Any violation of R.S. 14:95(E). 31 (8) Any violation of R.S. 40:966(C) or 967(C). 32 33 (9) Any crime under the laws of any other state or of the United States or of 34
