3	to Minors Act; to provide relative to the transfer of custodial property; to provide for		
4	the authority of the transferor; to provide for definitions; to provide for the age of		
5	termination of the custodianship; to provide for applicability; and to provide for		
6	related matters.		
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:		
8	Section 1. R.S. 9:751(1) and (10) and 770(1) are hereby amended and reenacted to		
9	read as follows:		
10	§751. Definitions		
11	As used in this Subpart:		
12	(1) "Adult" means an individual who has attained the age of eighteen twenty-		
13	two years.		
14	* * *		
15	(10) "Minor" means an individual who has not attained the age of eighteen		
16	twenty-two years.		
17	* * *		
18	§770. Termination of custodianship		
19	The custodian shall transfer in an appropriate manner the custodial property		
20	to the minor or to the minor's estate upon the earlier of the following:		
21	(1) The minor's attainment of eighteen twenty-two years of age.

23	Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall be given prospective application to all		
24	Uniform Transfer to Minor Accounts.

2	Minors Act for the benefit of a minor, yet to transfer, shall be subject to the provisions of
