- 2. Change the requirement for the use of surgical smoke plum evacuation system to a requirement for a surgical smoke plume evacuation plan.
- 3. Make technical changes.

Proposed law defines "surgical smoke plume".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires licensed healthcare facilities which provide surgical procedures using heat-producing equipment, including but not limited to electrosurgery and lasers, to adopt and implement policies for a surgical smoke plume evacuation plan to mitigate and remove the surgical smoke plume.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the La. Department of Health to verify compliance with <u>proposed law</u> through onsite surveys that are specific to surgical services, full licensing surveys, full recertification surveys, and complaint surveys if allegations specific to surgical services are alleged.
