

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2023 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Insurance to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 104 by Senator Stine

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 6, after "definitions;" insert "to provide for applicability;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 12, after "**disease**" insert "**or any other medical condition**"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 2, line 3, delete "**is supported**" and insert in lieu thereof "**provides clinical utility**
7 **as demonstrated**"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 2, line 13, after "**guidelines**" insert a period "." and delete the remainder of the line

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 2, delete line 14 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

12 **"(3) This Section does not require a health coverage plan to cover**
13 **biomarker testing for screening purposes.**"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 6

15 On page 2, line 19, after "**website**" insert "**or be clearly outlined in the notification of**
16 **adverse determination**"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 7

18 On page 3, delete lines 16 through 20 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

19 **"(3)(a) "Clinical utility" means a test result to provide information that**
20 **is used in the formulation of a treatment or monitoring strategy that informs a**
21 **patient's outcome and impacts the clinical decision.**

22 **(b) The most appropriate test may include both information that is**
23 **actionable and information that cannot be immediately used in the formulation**
24 **of a clinical decision.**"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 8

26 On page 3, after line 27, insert the following:

27 "Section 2. The provisions of this Act apply to any new policy, contract, program,
28 or health coverage plan issued on and after January 1, 2024. Any policy, contract, or health
29 coverage plan in effect prior to January 1, 2024, shall convert to conform to the provisions
30 of this Act on or before the renewal date, but no later than January 1, 2025."
