8 On page 4, delete lines 23 through 26 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

9	" <u>E.(1)(a) The pharmacy benefit manager quality incentive program shall</u>
10	be strictly voluntary and limited only to network pharmacies.
11	(b) No independent network pharmacy shall be penalized for declining
12	to participate.
13	(c) The opportunity to participate in a pharmacy benefit manager's
14	quality incentive program shall be separate and apart from the contract entered
15	into between the pharmacist and the pharmacy benefit manager to be in the
16	pharmacy benefit manager's network. Once a pharmacy agrees to participate
17	in a quality incentive program, terms of participation may be provided for in
18	a contract addendum or related contractual supplement. A pharmacy may be
19	in the pharmacy benefit manager's network and not participate in the quality
20	incentive program, but shall be in the network in order to be eligible to
21	participate.
22	(d) Terms of reimbursement for the acquisition and dispensing of
23	prescription drugs shall not be a part of the quality incentive program.
24	(e) Failure of a participating independent network pharmacy to meet the
25	terms of the quality incentive program may make it ineligible for incentive
26	payments and may make it ineligible to continue participating in the quality
27	incentive program. However, failure of the independent network pharmacy to
28	meet the terms and benchmarks of the quality incentive program shall not
29	result in penalties imposed upon the independent network pharmacy."
