### 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 3 through 16,
and insert the following:

B. The Department of Economic Development, through its offices and 18 19 officers, shall be responsible for fostering the growth of industry, ports, and other 20 commercial enterprises in Louisiana that will contribute to the overall improvement of the economy of the state. The department shall promote the advantages of 21 Louisiana to out-of-state business and industry, facilitate the expansion of existing 22 enterprises, including port development, and coordinate with other state agencies 23 24 and units of local government plans and programs aimed at developing optimum 25 conditions for new and expanding industrial and commercial enterprises in Louisiana. 26

- C.(1) The Department of Economic Development shall be composed of the
   executive office of the secretary, the office of management and finance, the office
   of business development, <u>the office of port development</u>, and such other offices as
   shall be created by law.

- 32 §104. Powers and duties of the secretary of economic development
- A. In addition to the functions, powers, and duties otherwise vested in the
  secretary by law, he shall:

- (14) Notwithstanding other provisions in this Subsection, the secretary of the
   Department of Economic Development may provide targeted economic development
   efforts in priority economic development zones. Such These targeted programs shall

be in addition to programs already in existence or any programs that may have been implemented in these areas by the department under normal circumstances. "Priority economic development zone" means any parish listed as one of the ten parishes with the highest unemployment rates in Louisiana and any municipality listed as one of the twenty-five municipalities with the highest unemployment rates in Louisiana as of July first of any given year and according to statistics compiled by the Louisiana Workforce Commission.

- 9 §107. Assistant secretaries

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10 A. Each office within the Department of Economic Development, except the 11 office of management and finance, the office of port development, and the office 12 of entertainment industry development, shall be under the immediate supervision and direction of an assistant secretary. The office of port development shall be under 13 the immediate supervision and direction of a commissioner of port 14 15 development. The assistant secretary or commissioner of each such office shall be 16 appointed by the governor with the consent of the Senate. Each shall serve at the 17 pleasure of the governor and shall be paid a salary which shall be fixed by the governor, which salary shall not exceed the amount approved for such position by 18 19 the legislature while in session.

B. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this Title, the duties and functions of each office and its assistant secretary <u>or commissioner</u> shall be determined by the secretary, and all of such duties and functions shall be exercised under the direct supervision and control of the secretary.

C. Except as otherwise provided in R.S. 36:801, each assistant secretary <u>or</u> <u>commissioner</u> shall employ, appoint, remove, assign, and promote such personnel as is necessary for the efficient administration of his office and its programs and the performance of its powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities, in accordance with applicable civil service laws, rules, and regulations, and with policies and rules of the department, all subject to budgetary control and applicable laws.

30D. Each assistant secretary or commissioner shall exercise all powers and31authority granted to him in this Title subject to the overall direction and control of32the secretary.
