<u>Present law</u> provides penalties for violations of <u>present law</u> relative to motor vehicles and traffic regulation (La. Highway Regulatory Act). <u>Present law</u> provides that the first violation of <u>present law</u> or any regulation made pursuant to <u>present law</u> is to be punished by a fine up to \$175 or imprisonment up to 30 days, or both. <u>Present law</u> further provides that a subsequent violation is to be punished by a fine up to \$500 or imprisonment up to 90 days, or both.

<u>Proposed law</u> permits law enforcement to impound the vehicle at the time of the violation.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if the offense is committed in preparation to or during the commission of a felony in order to escape detection, the violator is to be punished by an additional fine of \$200, or an additional imprisonment of 30 days, or both.

Proposed law otherwise retains present law.

Effective August 1, 2023.
