4 On page 3, at the beginning of line 4, change "**F.**" to "**E.**"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 3, after line 27, insert the following:

7 "Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall apply to any new policy, contract,  
8 program, or health coverage plan issued on or after the January first immediately following  
9 the effective date of this Act. Any policy, contract, or health coverage plan in effect prior  
10 to the effective date of this Act shall convert to conform to the provisions of this Act on or  
11 before the renewal date, but no later than the first January first that is at least one year after  
12 the effective date of this Act.

13 Section 3.(A) The provisions of Sections 1 and 2 of this Act shall become effective  
14 when an Act of the Louisiana Legislature containing a specific appropriation of monies for  
15 the implementation of the provisions of this Act becomes effective.

16 (B) The provisions of this Section shall become effective upon signature by the  
17 governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become  
18 law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the  
19 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the  
20 legislature, the provisions of this Section shall become effective on the day following such  
21 approval."
