Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 33 by Senator White

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete line 3 in its entirety and insert "1667.1(A)(1) and (2)(a) and (F)(2) and (3),
3 1667.7(B) and (G), and 1667.9 and to enact R.S. 40:1667.1(A)(4), relative to supplemental
4 pay"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 1

6 On page 2, delete lines 9 and 10 in their entirety and insert the following:

7 "Section 2. R.S. 40:1666.1(A)(1), (4)(a), and (6)(a), 1667.1(A)(1) and (2)(a) and
8 (F)(2) and (3), 1667.7(B) and (G), and 1667.9 are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
9 40:1667.1(A)(4) is hereby enacted to read as follows:"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

11 On page 4, between lines 26 and 27, insert the following:

13 "(4) Every sworn, commissioned law enforcement officer employed on a full-time
14 basis by a Louisiana public postsecondary education institution in the capacity of a police
15 officer by providing police services to the general public through effecting arrests, issuing
16 citations, and serving warrants shall be paid by the state extra compensation in the amount
17 of six hundred dollars per month in addition to the compensation now paid to him by his
18 employer. To be eligible for the extra compensation provided pursuant to this Paragraph,
19 each such law enforcement officer shall have completed one year of service, and any such
20 law enforcement officer after hired March 31, 1986, shall also have completed and passed
21 a council-certified training program, as provided in R.S. 40:2405.

26 (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the compensation
27 for tribal officers of the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe of Louisiana shall be for ~~no more than thirteen~~
28 ~~such~~ all eligible law enforcement officers.

29 (3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the compensation
30 for tribal officers of the Coushatta Indian Tribe of Louisiana shall be for no more than ~~eight~~
31 twenty such law enforcement officers, subject to approval by the sheriff of Allen Parish.

33 AMENDMENT NO. 4

34 On page 5, between lines 28 and 29, insert the following:

35 "Section 3. The legislative auditor is hereby directed to examine, investigate, and
36 audit the state's payment to eligible persons who receive state supplemental pay in
37 accordance with R.S. 13:2591 and R.S. 40:1666.1, 1667.1, 1667.7, and 1667.9. In his
38 examination, the legislative auditor shall examine the original purpose of the Louisiana
39 Legislature's enactment of the statutes regarding state supplemental pay and determine
40 whether current payments have deviated from the original purpose and whether current
41 payments are made in accordance with law. The legislative auditor shall recommend

1 modifications to the state supplemental pay program based upon the audit, report the impact
2 on the state budget if changes are enacted, and submit such report to the House Committee
3 on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance no later than February 1, 2024."

4 AMENDMENT NO. 5

5 On page 5, at the beginning of line 29, delete "Section 3." and insert "Section 4."
