To the Honorable President and Members of the Senate and to the Honorable Speaker and Members of the House of Representatives.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

We, the conferees appointed to confer over the disagreement between the two houses concerning Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 38 by Senator Robert Mills, recommend the following concerning the Original bill:

- 1. That House Floor Amendment No. 1 proposed by Representative Schexnayder and adopted by the House of Representatives on May 30, 2023, be rejected.
- 2. That the following amendment to the original bill be adopted:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, between lines 10 and 11, insert:

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the North Louisiana Legislative Delegation of the Legislature of Louisiana shall be provided funding, office space, equipment, or staff subject to availability and approval by the presiding officers."

Keyword and summary of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

LEGISLATORS. Recognizes the North Louisiana Legislative Delegation of the legislature.

Report rejects House amendments which would have:

1. Prevented the North Louisiana Legislative Delegation from being provided any funding, office space, equipment, or staff by the Legislature of Louisiana or any agency thereof.

Report amends bill to:

1. Provide the North Louisiana Legislative Delegation with funding, office space, equipment, or staff by the Legislature of Louisiana or any agency thereof subject to availability and approval by the presiding officers.

Digest of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

Recognizes the distinct group of members of the legislature representing in whole or in part the parishes of Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Caldwell, Catahoula, Claiborne, Concordia, DeSoto, East Carroll, Franklin, Grant, Jackson, LaSalle, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Red River, Richland, Sabine, Tensas, Union, Webster, West Carroll, and Winn as the North La. Legislative Delegation of the legislature.

Provides that the North La. Legislative Delegation of the legislature supercedes and replaces the North Louisiana Legislative Delegation of the House of Representatives.

Provides that the North La. Legislative Delegation of the legislature shall be allocated funding, office space, equipment, and staff by the Legislature of Louisiana or any agency thereof subject to availability and approval by the presiding officers.
