SB 156 2023 Regular Session Duplessis

Keyword and summary of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

INSURANCE POLICIES: Provides that no property insurance policy shall prohibit an insured from hiring a public adjuster. (8/1/23)

Report adopts House amendments to:

- 1. Exempt commercial insurance policies written by surplus lines insurers from the prohibition that disallows an insured the right to hire a public adjuster.
- 2. Make technical changes.

Report rejects House amendments which would have:

- 1. Required insurers to file a rate filing to the commissioner of insurance by Nov. 1, 2023.
- 2. Made technical changes.

Report amends the bill to:

- 1. Exempt commercial insurance policies written by surplus lines insurers from the prohibition that disallows an insured the right to hire a public adjuster.
- 2. Make technical changes.

Digest of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

<u>Present law</u> provides an insurer is authorized to include certain prohibitory provisions in a property insurance policy.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but prohibits an insurer from including a policy provision that disallows an insured the right to hire a public adjuster for services as provided by law.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts commercial insurance policies written by surplus lines insurers from the prohibition in <u>proposed law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2023.
