Existing law provides for the creation, organization, powers, and duties of a metropolitan planning commission to manage the metropolitan planning area in and around the municipality of Benton and includes certain unincorporated areas of Bossier Parish.

<u>Prior law</u> provided for a metropolitan planning area that included the village of Benton but was limited to the area lying within a five-mile radius outside of the village of Benton in the unincorporated part of Bossier Parish.

<u>New law</u> expands the jurisdictional boundaries of the metropolitan planning area to extend beyond the five-mile radius in <u>prior law</u> to also include a larger portion of the unincorporated area of Bossier Parish.

<u>New law</u> changes the term "village" to "municipality" to reflect the fact that the population of Benton has grown to such an extent that the area no longer meets the definition of a "village".

<u>Prior law</u> defined the "metropolitan planning commission" to mean the Benton-Parish Metropolitan Planning Commission.

<u>New law</u> defines the "metropolitan planning commission" to mean the Benton Metropolitan Planning Commission.

Effective August 1, 2023.
