Bourriaque

Existing law provides relative to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law.

<u>Existing law</u> provides for definitions of alcoholic beverages for low and high alcoholic content.

<u>New law</u> adds definitions for "distill, distilling, and distilled" and "manufacturing distillery" or "manufacturing distiller".

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes wine producers who are not performing any of the prohibited acts or whose license has not been suspended or revoked as provided in R.S. 26:90, who own and operate one or more wineries to sell or serve their finished products at retail to consumers at fairs, festivals, farmers' markets, and similar venues.

<u>New law</u> authorizes manufacturing distillers in compliance with R.S. 26:90 to sell or serve their products in the same manner as wine producers.

Effective August 1, 2023.
