## ACT 385 (HB 660) 2023 Regular Session

Existing law permits an individual who is a qualified retired law enforcement officer to carry a concealed firearm anywhere in the state, including any place open to the public, if he meets certain eligibility criteria.

<u>Existing law</u> requires a qualified retired law enforcement officer to qualify annually to obtain certification from the Council on Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) and to provide proof of such certification.

<u>New law</u> adds a retired officer who is properly certified by the P.O.S.T. Council at the time of retirement as an alternative requirement to <u>existing law</u>.

<u>New law</u> provides that an individual who is retired from service as a qualified law enforcement officer shall not be permitted the ability to carry a concealed firearm in another state without proper qualification under the provisions of <u>existing law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2023.
