<u>Existing law</u> creates the La. Board of Chiropractic Examiners (board) and provides for the composition of the board.

<u>New law</u> provides that the term of a member of the board shall be four years from the date of appointment.

<u>Prior law</u> required the board to notify an applicant for licensure whether his application was accepted or rejected after investigation of the application, but not less than 30 days prior to applicant's licensing exam.

<u>New law</u> repeals <u>prior law</u> and requires the board to provide notice within 10 business days of a determination of acceptance or rejection.

<u>New law</u> provides that notice of acceptance or rejection may be sent via U.S. Postal Service, commercial carrier, email, or facsimile.

Effective August 1, 2023.
