

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 369 (HB 459)**

Existing law exempts a phlebotomist or an individual acting as a phlebotomist from certification requirements if he is employed by a licensed physician, clinic, hospital, nursing home, or licensed healthcare facility.

New law retains existing law and provides that a phlebotomists or an individual acting as a phlebotomist is not required to be certified as a phlebotomist if employed by a testing location or laboratory licensed or certified under the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 and the facility provides at least five days of phlebotomist training and two weeks of on-the-job training.

New law removes provisions with effective dates or deadlines in prior law that occurred before Jan. 1, 2000.

Effective August 1, 2023.
