**Abstract:** Provides for an increase in wireless telephone service charges for 911 emergency services in the Terrebonne Parish Communications District.

Present law provides for the creation of parish communications districts which provide 911 services and which are funded by service charges on telephone service.

Present law provides that a governing authority of any communications district may levy a commercial mobile radio service (CMRS) telephone service charge not to exceed \$1.25/month per wireless CMRS connection.

Proposed law provides for an exception; authorizes the governing authority of the Terrebonne Parish Communications District to levy a CMRS telephone service charge at a rate of not more than \$1.85/month per wireless CMRS connection.
