- 10 On page 2, at the beginning of line 3, change "410.10," to "410.11,"
- 11 AMENDMENT NO. 5
- 12 On page 6, between lines 14 and 15, insert the following:
- 13 "§410.11. Majority vote required
- A candidate who receives a majority of the votes cast for a party primary
- office in a general election is elected. If no candidate receives a majority of votes,
- the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes are qualified as candidates
- in a subsequent election on the third Saturday after the date on which the results in
- the general election were promulgated."

19 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 6</u>

- 20 On page 13, delete lines 4 through 21 in their entirety and insert the following:
- "Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor
- or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law
- without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the
- 24 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by
- 25 the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
