1 AN ACT

2 To repeal R.S. 11:2220(J), relative to the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System;  
3 to remove limitations on payment of benefits to certain reemployed retirees; and to  
4 provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published  
6 as provided by Article X, Section 29(C) of the Constitution  
7 of Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 11:2220(J) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**Abstract:** Repeals a required benefit suspension for retirees who are reemployed in certain positions in the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System (MPERS).

Present law, relative to MPERS, requires the suspension of benefits of a retiree who becomes reemployed in certain positions within 12 months of his retirement. Provides that the suspension remains in effect for the duration of employment or until 12 months after his retirement, whichever occurs first. Provides exceptions.

Proposed law repeals present law.
