8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 11:3383(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§3383. Minimum pension for firefighters on retired list
11	A. Any other provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, each
12	firefighter on the retired list of the fire department and each surviving spouse of a
13	member of the fire department shall receive a pension of not less than twelve fifteen
14	hundred dollars per month.

Abstract: Increases the minium benefit for members of the New Orleans Firefighters' Pension and Relief Fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the minimum benefit for each member and surviving spouse of the New Orleans Firefighters' Pension and Relief Fund is \$1,200 per month.

Proposed law increases this minium benefit to \$1,500 per month.
