Abstract: Removes the requirement that clerks of district courts collect and disburse a fee and submit certain information required by the supreme court when suit has been filed in district court for damages arising from an offense or quasi offense.

<u>Present law</u> requires clerks of district courts to collect and disburse a fee and submit information required by the supreme court when a suit has been filed in district court for damages arising from an offense or quasi offense.

<u>Present law</u> provides that information received by the judicial administrator pursuant to <u>present law</u> is not subject to subpoena.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
