1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the end of line 21, add the following:

3 "In addition to serving the district attorney for the jurisdiction where the underlying  
4 conviction was obtained, any application filed after the first application for post  
5 conviction relief shall be served on the district attorney and the attorney general at  
6 least sixty days in advance of the hearing on the application. Both the district  
7 attorney and the attorney general shall have a right to suspensively appeal any order  
8 granting relief."

9 AMENDMENT NO. 2

10 On page 2, line 4, after "shall be" and before "and shall" change "mandatory" to  
11 "jurisdictional"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 3

13 On page 3, line 7, after "shall be" and before "and shall" change "mandatory" to  
14 "jurisdictional"
