SB 12 Original

Seabaugh

Present law provides that a candidate for sheriff, tax assessor, or clerk of court shall have resided in the state for the preceding two years and shall have been actually domiciled for the preceding year in the parish from which he seeks election at the time he files his notice of candidacy.

Proposed law retains present law and provides an exception for a candidate for sheriff who previously served a deputy sheriff and assumed the office of sheriff as a result of the retirement, resignation, or removal from office of the previous sheriff to establish domicile within the parish he serves within 6 months, after which he shall be eligible to seek reelection.

Effective August 1, 2024.
