**Abstract:** Increases the penalties for public bribery.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the crime of public bribery.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides that whoever commits the crime of public bribery shall be fined not more than \$1,000, or imprisoned, with or without hard labor, for not more than five years, or both.

Proposed law changes the penalty to provide for a maximum fine of \$2,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> further changes the penalty of imprisonment, to be served with or without hard labor, <u>from</u> a maximum of five years to 10 years.
