<u>Present law</u> requires that the minimum school day for grades one through 12 in every public school in the state consist of 360 minutes of instructional time, exclusive of all recesses. <u>Present law</u> further requires that the minimum school year consist of 177 days of instruction.

<u>Propose law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds the requirement that the minimum school week for grades one through 12 in every public school in the state consist of five consecutive days within a week, except for acknowledged legal holidays.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
