| 6 | §440.3. Cardiac health; student athletes, parents; communication |
| 7 | A. The state Department of Education shall provide written information to |
| 8 | public school governing authorities relative to cardiac health. Such information shall |
| 9 | include at a minimum requirement that a student athlete who has or has had a cardiac |
| 10 | health issue must meet before returning to participation in athletics. |
| 11 | B. Each public school governing authority shall distribute the information |
| 12 | provided for in Subsection A of this Section in writing to student athletes and their |
| 13 | parents and legal guardians. Coaches, athletic trainers, athletic directors, or other |
| 14 | appropriate school personnel shall collect signatures from parents indicating receipt |
| 15 | and understanding of the requirements outlined in the communication. |

Abstract: Requires distribution of certain cardiac health information to student athletes and their parents.

<u>Present law</u> requires each public school nurse, coach, athletic trainer, and athletic director, to complete annually a sudden cardiac arrest education program developed by the state Dept. of Education (DOE).

<u>Proposed law</u> further requires DOE to provide to public school governing authorities written communication relative to student athletes returning to athletics after a cardiac event. Requires public school governing authorities to distribute such communication to parents and legal guardians of athletes and to obtain signatures acknowledging receipt and understanding.
