EDUCATION: Repeals certain student instruction and teacher training requirements and authorizes the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to adopt policies requiring the inclusion of certain topics in such instruction and training

AN ACT

R.S. 17:6(A)(15) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 17:6(A)(16) 13 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 14 §6. General powers of board 15 A. In the exercise of its supervision and control over the public elementary 16 and secondary schools and special schools under its jurisdiction, and in the exercise 17 of its budgetary responsibility for all funds appropriated or allocated by the state for

1 public elementary and secondary schools and special schools placed under its 2 jurisdiction, the board shall have authority to: 3 4 (15) Adopt policies that require the inclusion of certain topics in student 5 instruction and in the training of teachers and other school employees. 6 (16) Perform such other functions as are necessary to the supervision and 7 control of those phases of education under its supervision and control. 8 9 Section 2. Abstract: Repeals certain student instruction and teacher/employee training requirements and authorizes the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to adopt policies requiring the inclusion of certain topics in such instruction and training.

<u>Present law</u> requires student instruction on the following: adoption awareness, breast and cervical exams, CPR and automated external defibrillators, child assault, cursive writing, dating violence, eating disorders, internet and cell phone safety, litter, mental health, organ donation, parenthood, safe haven laws, shaken baby syndrome, substance abuse, and water safety.

<u>Present law</u> requires teacher/school employee training on the following: adverse childhood experiences and trauma-informed education, classroom management, bullying, communicable disease and control, first aid, sudden cardiac arrest, and suicide prevention.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals these requirements and authorizes BESE to adopt policies that require the inclusion of certain topics in student instruction and in the training of teachers of other school employees.
