HOUSE BILL NO. 339

PUBLIC FACILITIES: Provides relative to acceptable payment types at air carrier airports

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 2:135.4, relative to acceptable forms of payment at air carrier airports; to
3 authorize air carrier airports and their agents to receive certain types of payment for
4 transactions; to prohibit air carrier airports and their agents from refusing to accept
5 certain payments for transactions; to provide for exceptions; and to provide for
6 related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 2:135.4 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 §135.4. Payment methods at airports

10 A. For purposes of this Section, the term "authorized agent" shall mean any
11 non-aeronautical service at the airport which provides business or products which are
12 not associated with aviation.

13 B.(1) All air carrier airports or their authorized agents may collect payment
14 by credit card, debit card, or a similar approved payment device for any transaction
15 including but not limited to parking, food and beverage, or other consumer-related
16 purchases.

17 (2) No air carrier airport or its authorized agent shall prohibit the use of
18 United States currency, coin or paper money, for the payment of such transactions.

19 C. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to the purchase of airline
20 tickets, luggage fees, purchases through the airline, or rental vehicle fees.

Abstract: Defines "authorized agents" and authorizes air carrier airports to accept debit card, credit card, or a similar approved payment device. Restricts airports from prohibiting the use of U.S. currency for any transaction including but not limited to parking, food and beverage, or other consumer-related purchases, and provides an exemption for purchases through airline and rental car companies.

Proposed law defines "authorized agent" as any non-aeronautical service at the airport which provides business or products which are not associated with aviation.

Proposed law authorizes all air carrier airports or their agents to collect payment by credit card, debit card, or a similar approved payment device for any transaction including but not limited to parking, food and beverage, or other consumer-related purchases.

Proposed law restricts all air carrier airports or their agents from prohibiting the use of U.S. currency, coin or paper money, for the payment of any transaction including but not limited to parking, food and beverage, or other consumer-related purchases.

Proposed law provides an exemption from proposed law for the purchase of airline tickets, luggage fees, purchases through the airline, and rental vehicle fees.
