Amendments proposed by Senator McMath to Reengrossed House Bill No. 4 by Representative Emerson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Senate Committee Amendments Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 proposed by the Senate
3 Committee on Judiciary B and adopted by the Senate on February 26, 2024.

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, line 28, after "conviction" insert the following:

6 "and is seeking relief pursuant to Article 926.2 and five years or more have elapsed
7 since the petitioner pled guilty or nolo contendere to the offense of conviction"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 3, after line 11, add the following:

10 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective on August 1, 2024; if vetoed by the
11 governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on
12 the day following such approval by the legislature or August 1, 2024, whichever is later."
