Present law provides for the regulation of the sale and service of alcoholic beverages by a person holding a Class A-General Permit issued by the office of alcohol and tobacco control.

Present law prohibits the sale or service of alcoholic beverages by a permit holder to any person under the age of 21.

Present law provides for limitation of liability in certain circumstances for the state, a state agency, or a political subdivision of the state or any person for injury, death, or loss of the operator of a motor vehicle, aircraft, watercraft, or vessel who was operating the vehicle, aircraft, watercraft, or vessel with a BAC of 0.08% or more or was under the influence of any controlled dangerous substance as provided by present law.

Proposed law provides that the present law limitation of liability does not apply to a person holding a Class A-General Permit if the operator of a motor vehicle, aircraft, watercraft, or vessel under the age of 21 is sold or served alcoholic beverages by the permit holder.

Present law provides for limitation of liability for loss connected with sale, serving, or furnishing of alcoholic beverages.

Proposed law retains present law and provides that the present law limitation of liability shall not apply to any Class A-General Permit holder who sells alcoholic beverages to a person under the age of 21.

Effective August 1, 2024.
