<u>Present LAC</u> 76:V.131 provides for the Wildlife Rehabilitation Program permitting and operations. <u>Present LAC</u> 76:V.131(E)(4) provides for permit requirements for the Wildlife Rehabilitation Program, and requires completion of a course certified by the La. Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries (LDWF). <u>Proposed law</u> requires that the course be readily available online, with completion subject to an interactive test, and a \$125 fee requirement.

<u>Present LAC</u> 76:V.131(E)(5) requires applicants to have verification of having access to veterinary services by submitting a Statement of Veterinary Support Form provided by the LDWF. <u>Proposed law</u> requires an applicant to agree to have access to veterinary services.

<u>Present LAC</u> 76:V.131(E)(6) allows for inspection of an applicant's animal housing facilities by the LDWF. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that an applicant shall have a suitable housing for the animal and shall report the habitat specifications to the department.

<u>Present LAC</u> 76:V.131(F)(7)(a) prohibits wildlife permit holders from possessing the following: (1) non-migratory birds for more than 90 days; (2) other injured wildlife for more than 45 days; and (3) other orphaned wildlife longer than required for release, not to exceed 120 days. Additionally, provides for a written request for extension of possession if the animal is currently nonreleasable but will likely be releasable after the listed time frame, or if a veterinarian determines that the animal requires additional rehabilitation time. <u>Proposed law</u> removes the provisions of <u>present law</u> relative to the written request for extension and provides that the hold limitations do not apply if the animal is otherwise nonreleasable.
