LEGISLATIVE AGENCIES: Creates a commission of the legislature to provide certain services in the area around the capitol complex

| 7 | Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: | | |
| 8 | Section 1. Chapter 12-A of Title 24 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, | | |
| 9 | comprised of R.S. 24:701 through 705, is hereby enacted to read as follows: | | |
| 10 | §701. State Capitol Complex Neighborhood Improvements Council | | |
| 11 | A. There is hereby created the State Capitol Complex Neighborhood | | |
| 12 | Improvements Council as an agency of the legislature. | | |
| 13 | B. The council shall be composed of ten members as follows: | | |
| 14 | (1) The president of the Senate. | | |
| 15 | (2) Four members appointed by the president of the Senate from the | | |
| 16 | membership of the Senate. | | |
| 17 | (3) The speaker of the House of Representatives. | | |
| 18 | (4) Four members appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives | | |
| 19 | from the membership of the House of Representatives. | | |

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| 1 | $\underline{C.(1)}$ Appointments to the council shall be made no later than twenty days |
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| 2 | after the adjournment of the organizational session of the legislature. |
| 3 | (2) Any vacancy in the appointed membership of the council shall be filled |
| 4 | in the manner of original appointment for the remainder of the term. |
| 5 | D. The positions of chairman and vice chairman of the council shall rotate |
| 6 | in even-numbered years between the members of the House of Representatives and |
| 7 | the members of the Senate who serve on the council as provided in this Section. In |
| 8 | January of each even-numbered year, the speaker of the House of Representatives |
| 9 | shall designate a member of the House of Representatives on the council who shall |
| 10 | serve as chairman or vice chairman of the council, as applicable, and the president |
| 11 | of the Senate shall designate a member of the Senate on the council who shall serve |
| 12 | as chairman or vice chairman of the council, as applicable. |
| 13 | <u>§702. Jurisdiction</u> |
| 14 | The council shall exercise its powers and duties within the areas in the state |
| 15 | capitol complex that are occupied and utilized by the members, officers, and staff of |
| 16 | the legislative branch of state government. For purposes of this Chapter, the term |
| 17 | "state capitol complex" means that area in the city of Baton Rouge, containing the |
| 18 | state capitol building and bounded on the south by Main Street, on the west by the |
| 19 | Mississippi River, on the north by Choctaw Drive, and on the east by the Kansas |
| 20 | City Southern Railway tracks. |
| 21 | <u>§703. Purpose</u> |
| 22 | A. The council shall take steps to provide or enhance security patrols in the |
| 23 | state capitol complex, provide for improved lighting, signage, or matters relating to |
| 24 | the security of the state capitol complex, provide for improvements in the state |
| 25 | capitol complex, and to provide generally for the overall betterment of the state |
| 26 | capitol complex and the quality of life of its residents and visitors. |
| 27 | §704. Exemption |

| 1 | In the exercise of authority granted by this Chapter, improvements |
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| 2 | undertaken by the council are not subject to permits otherwise required by the City |
| 3 | of Baton Rouge and Parish of East Baton Rouge. |
| 4 | <u>§705. Duties</u> |
| 5 | The council shall have such powers and duties as are conferred upon it by this |
| 6 | Chapter and such other duties as are provided by law. |

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Abstract: Creates the State Capitol Complex Neighborhood Improvements Council.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the State Capitol Complex Neighborhood Improvements Council for the purpose of certain matters relative to the capitol complex, including the following:

- (1) Enhancing security.
- (2) Providing for improvements.
- (3) Providing generally for its betterment for its residents and visitors.

Proposed law provides for membership and jurisdiction.
