There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Change {S & H}

This measure may increase agency self-generated revenues for the Board by \$44,530 annually, depending on the number of transactions per year and when the fee increases go into effect. A Board official indicated, based on fiscal year 2023 data, the fee changes may increase Board revenue by \$44,530 annually, depending on the number of applications, renewals, and other transactions per year and when the fee increases go into effect. The Board was established in 2014 and indicated licensing fees have never been increased and the increase in fees is needed to offset effects of inflation. Below is a summary of how each fee increase contributes to the overall revenue increase:
