CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES: Provides relative to distribution of fentanyl under certain circumstances

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 40:967.1, relative to controlled dangerous substances; to provide
3	for the unlawful distribution of fentanyl under certain circumstances; to provide for
4	a penalty; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 40:967.1 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§967.1. Prohibited actsSchedule II; distribution of fentanyl with certain
8	characteristics
9	A. Any person who violates the provisions of R.S. 40:967(A) with respect
10	to fentanyl, where the fentanyl or packaging of the fentanyl reasonably appeals in a
11	manner where there is reasonable appeal to a minor due to the shape, color, taste, or
12	design of the fentanyl or the fentanyl's packaging, shall be imprisoned at hard labor
13	for not less than twenty-five years nor more than ninety-nine years without benefit
14	of probation, parole, or suspension of sentence.
15	B. Any person who violates the provisions of R.S. 40:967(A) with respect
16	to fentanyl, where the fentanyl or packaging of the fentanyl is designed to resemble
17	branded prescription medication or its generic equivalent, shall be imprisoned at hard
18	labor for not less than ten years nor more than forty years without benefit of
19	probation, parole, or suspension of sentence.
20	<u>C.</u> For the purposes of this Section, the following definitions shall apply:

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

1	(1) "Fentanyl" shall mean a substance or mixture containing a detectable
2	amount of fentanyl or its analogues, or carfentanil or a mixture or substance
3	containing a detectable amount of carfentanil or its analogues.
4	(2) "Reasonable appeal" "Reasonably appeals" shall mean a design of the
5	fentanyl or the fentanyl's packaging, including that includes but is not to limited to
6	a resemblance of any of the following:
7	(a) A noncontrolled substance that is primarily consumed by and marketed
8	to minors.
9	(b) The shape of an animal, vehicle, person, or character.
10	(c) Food or beverage that is attractive to minors and that is commonly sold
11	in retail establishments, regardless of whether the food or beverage is generic,
12	trademarked, or a branded product.
13	(d) Candy.

Abstract: Provides relative to distribution of fentanyl, where the fentanyl or packaging of the fentanyl is designed to resemble branded prescription medication or its generic equivalent, and provides for penalties.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the crime of distribution of fentanyl with certain characteristics and provides for penalties.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any person who violates the provisions of <u>present law</u> (R.S. 40:967(A)) with respect to fentanyl, where the fentanyl or packaging of the fentanyl is designed to resemble branded prescription medication or its generic equivalent, shall be imprisoned at hard labor for not less than 10 years nor more than 40 years without benefit of probation, parole, or suspension of sentence.
