2 To commend STEM NOLA Fellow Jayden Marion Hall on his selection as a 2024
3 Champion in the National STEM Challenge.

4 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to commend STEM NOLA Fellow Jayden Marion Hall,
5 who has been selected as a champion of the National STEM Challenge; and

6 WHEREAS, Jayden Marion Hall is a twelfth grader at Brother Martin High School;

8 WHEREAS, the National STEM Challenge invited students in grades six through
9 twelve from across the United States and its territories to conceive and submit STEM
10 innovations, inventions, and research; 2,549 student entries from across fifty states and U.S.
11 territories were submitted; ultimately, one hundred twenty-six stand-out students were
12 selected as National STEM Champions and will have the opportunity to showcase their
13 projects at the National STEM Festival in Washington, D.C.; and

14 WHEREAS, Dr. Calvin Mackie, Founder of STEM NOLA, said, "I am thrilled to
15 witness the incredible achievements of our STEM NOLA Fellows, Naya Ellis and Jayden
16 Hall, as they emerge as champions in the National STEM Challenge. Their innovative
17 projects exemplify the transformative power of STEM education. These young minds not
18 only showcase exceptional creativity but also embody the spirit of problem-solving that is
19 crucial for the future"; and

1 WHEREAS, the achievement of being selected as a STEM NOLA fellow and
2 champion is truly impressive, and Jayden Marion Hall is most deserving of recognition for
3 his hard work and intellect.
