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SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 7

BY SENATOR BARROW

CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES. Urges and requests the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to provide the Senate committees on finance and judiciary C with a list of rehabilitative programs that are offered at each correctional facility.

A RESOLUTION

2	To urge and request the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to prepare and deliver
3	to the Senate Committee on the Judiciary C and the Senate Committee on Finance,
4	no later than June 30, 2024, a list of any and all educational, vocational, substance
5	abuse treatment, faith-based, values development, or other rehabilitative programs
6	available to inmates at each of the department's correctional facilities.
7	WHEREAS, crime ranks among the highest areas of concern for Louisiana residents,
8	with fifty-three percent of its adult population having experienced physical violence; and
9	WHEREAS, Louisiana has the highest incarceration rate per capita in the United
10	States, with one in twenty-six adults under correctional control; and
11	WHEREAS, Louisiana has over a forty percent, five year recidivism rate; and
12	WHEREAS, one of the stated responsibilities of the Department of Public Safety and
13	Corrections is to administer programs designed to protect persons in its custody and prepare
14	them for release; and
15	WHEREAS, the availability of effective rehabilitative programs to inmates is crucial
16	to reducing recidivism, decreasing the prison population, and preventing future crime.
17	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
18	does hereby urge and request the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to prepare

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and deliver to the Senate Committee on the Judiciary C and the Senate Committee on Finance, no later than June 30, 2024, a list of any and all educational, vocational, substance abuse treatment, faith-based, values development, or other rehabilitative programs available to inmates at each of the department's correctional facilities.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the list shall include the number of incarcerated persons at each correctional facility participating in each of the programs, the percentage of the facility population that is participating in each program, and the completion percentage for each program by facility.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to James M. LeBlanc, secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections.
