CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE. Adds Tianeptine to Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Law. (8/1/24)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 40:964(Schedule I)(G), relative to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous  
3 Substances Law; to add Tianeptine to Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled  
4 Dangerous Substances Law; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 40:964(Schedule I)(G) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §964. Composition of schedules

8 Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V shall, unless and until added to pursuant to R.S.  
9 40:962, consist of the following drugs or other substances, by whatever official  
10 name, common or usual name, chemical name, or brand name designated:

13 **G. Miscellaneous. Unless specifically excepted or contained within a**  
14 **pharmaceutical product approved by the United States Food and Drug**  
15 **Administration, or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound,**  
16 **mixture, or preparation which contains any quantity of the following substance,**  
17 **including its salts, isomers, or salts of isomers, whenever the existence of such**

1           **salts, isomers, or salts of isomers is possible within the specific chemical**

Present law provides for the designation of controlled dangerous substances in Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law.

Proposed law adds Tianeptine, a non-prescription antidepressant, to Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law.

Effective August 1, 2024.
