Abstract: Creates several special prestige license plates and provides for the creation, issuance, design, implementation, fees, distribution, and promulgation of rules applicable to these license plates.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from the "3" for Cyclists" special license plate royalty fee be used solely to assist the Metro Bicycle Coalition of New Orleans.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the monies from the "Support Our Wildlife Rehabilitators" plates be used to assist with the costs of wildlife rehabilitation.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from the "St. Thomas Aquinas" specialty license plate be solely used to assist the administration.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from the "Evangel Christian Academy" plate be used solely to assist the school.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from the "Icitte on parle français" specialty license plate be used solely to assist Télé-Louisiane French programming LPB.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from "Bienvenue en Louisiane" be used to assist L'Assemblée de la Louisiane fund initiative to promote French in Louisiana and expand French immersion in schools.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from "Lâche Pas" be used to assist Lâche Pas Vermilion cultural heritage program.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from "Bayou Indian" be used to assist Ecole Pointe-au-Chien French immersion programming.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from "Bayou Cajun" be used to assist Ecole Pointe-au-Chien French immersion programming.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier" be used to assist the creation of a French immersion program in Cameron Parish.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from "United States Submarine Veterans" be used to provide scholarships for children.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from " Leesville High School Alumni' be used to provide scholarships.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from" Humane Society of Louisiana" be used to fund spay and neuter programs to help with current overpopulation of animals.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections issue a special prestige license plates to be known as the "3' for Cyclists", "Support Our Wildlife Rehabilitators", "St. Thomas Aquinas", "Evangel Christian Academy", Icitte on parle français", "Bienvenue en Louisiane", "Lâche Pas", "Bayou Indian", "Bayou Cajun", "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier", "United States Submarine Veterans", "Leesville High School Alumni", and "Humane Society of Louisiana" specialty license plates, provided there is a minimum of 1,000 applicants for each plate.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the secretary work in conjunction with the Metro Bicycle Coalition of New Orleans to select the color and design of the "3' for Cyclists" plate. Further requires the design include the words "3' for Cyclists".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the secretary work in conjunction with the Wildlife Rehabilitators Support Council to select the color and design of the "Support our Wildlife Rehabilitators" plate. Further requires the design to include an image or logo of a wild animal, and include the words "Support our Wildlife Rehabilitators".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary work in conjunction with St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic school to select the color and design of the "St. Thomas Aquinas" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "St. Thomas Aquinas".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the secretary work in conjunction with Evangel Christian Academy administration to select the color and design of the "Evangel Christian Academy" the plate. Further requires the design to include the words "Evangel Christian Academy".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the secretary work in conjunction with Télé-Louisiane to select the color and design of the "Icitte on parle français" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "Icitte on parle français".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the secretary work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane, to select the color and design of the "Bienvenue en Louisiane" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "Bienvenue en Louisiane".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the secretary work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane, to select the color and design of the "Lâche Pas" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "Lâche Pas".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to work in conjunction with Ecole Pointe-au-Chien, to select the color and design of the "Bayou Indian" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "Bayou Indian".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary work in conjunction with Ecole Pointe-au-Chien, to select the color and design of the "Bayou Cajun" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "Bayou Cajun".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane in consultation with local residents of Cameron Parish, to select the color and design of the "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to work in conjunction with the United States Submarine Veterans Charitable Foundation, Inc., to select the color and design of the United States Submarine Veterans" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "United States Submarine Veterans".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to work in conjunction with the Alumni Association Executive Board, to select the color and design of the "Leesville High School Alumni" plate. Further requires the design include the words "Leesville High School Alumni".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to work in conjunction with the Humane Society of Louisiana, to select the color and design of the "Humane Society of Louisiana" plate. Further requires the design include the words "Humane Society of Louisiana".

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that the license plates be issued, upon application, to any citizen of La. in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the department to collect an annual royalty fee of \$25 in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax and a \$3.50 handling fee for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative costs.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to promulgate and adopt rules and regulations to implement the provisions provided in <u>proposed law</u>.

Directs the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, to create the "Share the Road", "Support Our Wildlife Rehabilitators", "St. Thomas Aquinas", "Evangel Christian Academy", "Icitte on parle français", Bienvenue en Louisiane", "Lâche Pas", "Bayou Indian", "Bayou Cajun", "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier", "United States Submarine Veterans", "Leesville High School Alumni", and "Humane Society of Louisiana" speciality license plates when the applicable statutory provisions are met and its system is updated to accommodate the creation of new plates.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Transportation, Highways and</u> <u>Public Works</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

- 1. Change the "Share the Road" specialty plate to the "3' for Cyclists" plate.
- 2. Add the "Icitte on parle français", "Bienvenue en Louisiane", "Lâche Pas", "Bayou Indian", "Bayou Cajun", "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier", "United States Submarine Veterans", "Leesville High School Alumni", and the "Humane Society of Louisiana" special prestige license plates and provides for the creation, issuance, design, implementation, fees, distribution, and promulgation of rules applicable to these plates.
