Provides for the right to contraception. (8/1/24)

Proposed legislation provides for the right of individuals to access contraceptives, emergency contraceptives, and information related to contraceptives. In addition, a health care provider shall have the corresponding right to provide contraceptives, emergency contraceptives, and information related to contraceptives. Proposed law provides that no law or regulation of the state shall impede access to contraceptives, emergency contraceptives, or information related to such.

Proposed law provides that the Attorney General may bring an action for injunctive relief against any person who violates provisions of this law.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The impact to the attorney general's office is indeterminable, and will depend on the number of complaints that cost of enforcement (injunctive relief) for each case. Any person, entity, or healthcare provider can file a petition for injunctive relief against a person in violation of the provisions of this measure. Proposed law authorizes the attorney general discretion relative to enforcement of proposed violations. Information provided by the attorney general indicates the cost of injunctive relief varies by the cost of enforcement; however, projects the cost of enforcement via injunctive relief will average approximately \$25,000 per action.

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
